Dear Doctor:

Our records indicate that you may have in your possession a Toftness Radiation Detector, the white cylindrical instrument with rexolite-plastic lenses in which you were instructed at the Toftness Post-Graduate School of Chiropractic, Cumberland, Wisconsin.

As a result of a jury verdict rendered in the case identified above, a judgment has been entered against the Toftness Radiation Detector requiring that it no longer be manufactured, sold, leased or used, that all Toftness Radiation Detector leases be canceled and that all the instruments be returned to us for delivery to the FDA. A copy of the judgment is enclosed.

Your attention is invited to paragraph 3c of the judgment (bottom of page 2). In accordance with that paragraph, we must direct as follows:

1. All leases or other agreements by which you are in possession of a Toftness Radiation Detector are hereby canceled.
2. All Toftness Radiation Detectors in your possession are to be returned within ten days of receipt of this letter to:

The judgment states that postage or other shipping charges are to be at the expense of the Toftness Post-Graduate School, Inc. The school will pay such expense, if you wish. We do request, however, that to help us keep the burden of this judgment to a minimum, you ship by United Parcel Service, uninsured. We would appreciate it if you would voluntarily pay the return shipping charge.
